FEBRUARY 18TH 2024 - FISHING DERBY RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. This is a family day fun weekend catch and release event designed to promote lake education, family fishing, and fundraising for LEPA.
- 2. Each participant will have to fill out the provided Fish Catch Form and return the completed form to the registration desk prior to the prizes being distributed. This will be used by LEPA to track the number of fish caught during the derby.
- 3. This is not a cash prize event, prizes are donated items.
- 4. The number of prize draw is dependent on the number of donated items.
- 5. Every family who wants to participate in the event must purchase a \$20.00 LEPA membership. To participate in the prizes, the cost is \$5 per family member.
- 6. If you catch a fish (perch or pike) in the event, between 10 am and 2 pm, you will be entered into the draw for the donated items. Proof of your catch must be captured on the Fish Catch Form prior to 2 pm.
- 7. Tents will be permitted.
- 8. All fishing must comply with 2023/2024 Alberta Guide to Sportfishing Regulations.
 - a. Note: Family Day Weekend anglers do not require a fishing license
- 9. This is a catch and release event no retention of fish is permitted, for protection of fish there are a number of rules that apply:
 - a. No fishing in depths exceeding 25'
 - b. 1 fishing line per licensed angler
 - c. Barbless Hooks to be used
 - d. Bait allowed per Alberta sportfishing guidelines for Lac La Nonne
 - e. Absolutely no passing of fish between participants.
 - f. Participants must provide a cooler that is sufficient size and fill with lake water to place fish in a natural swimming position. Quickly take a photo and return the fish to the lake as quickly as possible.
 - g. Only Northern Pike and Yellow Perch will be accepted as photo proof of a successful catch; measurement is not necessary.
 - h. All other species excluding Northern Pike and Yellow Perch must be released back into the lake in the most harmless way possible, ideally without removing them from the water if possible.
